The local currency is the KM (Convertible Mark) also called BAM, there are approx 1.95 to €1, the rate is fixed and money is easily exchanged in the banks in UNITIC Business center, the twin tower complex in which the OSCE Hq is located, next to the hotel, there are also many ATM machines from which money can be withdrawn. Some business will accept euro if your stuck but avoid large notes as change can be a problem.
