

Case Study 1

A.V. is a 14 year old girl from a village in Zvecan Municipality called Rudare. She was living with her mother in poor economical conditions. She was going to a primary school in Zvecan. One day, she makes an acquaintance with a person K.V., who is around 30 years old.

After some time, one of her the teachers goes to the Center for Social Work (CSW) to report the absence of A.V. from the school.

Afterwards, police is informed and A.V. is interviewed by the police.
