### **Background Note**

Fulfilling tasks arising from relevant MC decisions<sup>1</sup>, and following recommendations of the previously held events<sup>2</sup>, the OSCE Strategic Police Matters Unit (SPMU) is organising a three-day training seminar in Vilnius between 25 and 27 May 2011. The seminar will be held at the Lithuanian Parliament under the auspices of the Lithuanian Ombudsman for Children Rights. This event is a follow up of an on-line workshop implemented between 21 February and 4 March 2011.

The training seminar aims at improving capacities of law enforcement authorities in Eastern Europe in the detection, investigation and prosecution of sexual abuse of children on the Internet through enhanced law enforcement international cooperation and coordination. During the seminar the participants will analyse current trends in sexual abuse of children, identify gaps in national legislation, share best practices in detecting sites with child abuse material and identifying child victims.

The regional seminar will be facilitated by cyber-crime experts from EUROPOL, Sweden, France and Lithuania. The working languages of the Seminar will be English, Russian and Lithuanian with a simultaneous translation.
